

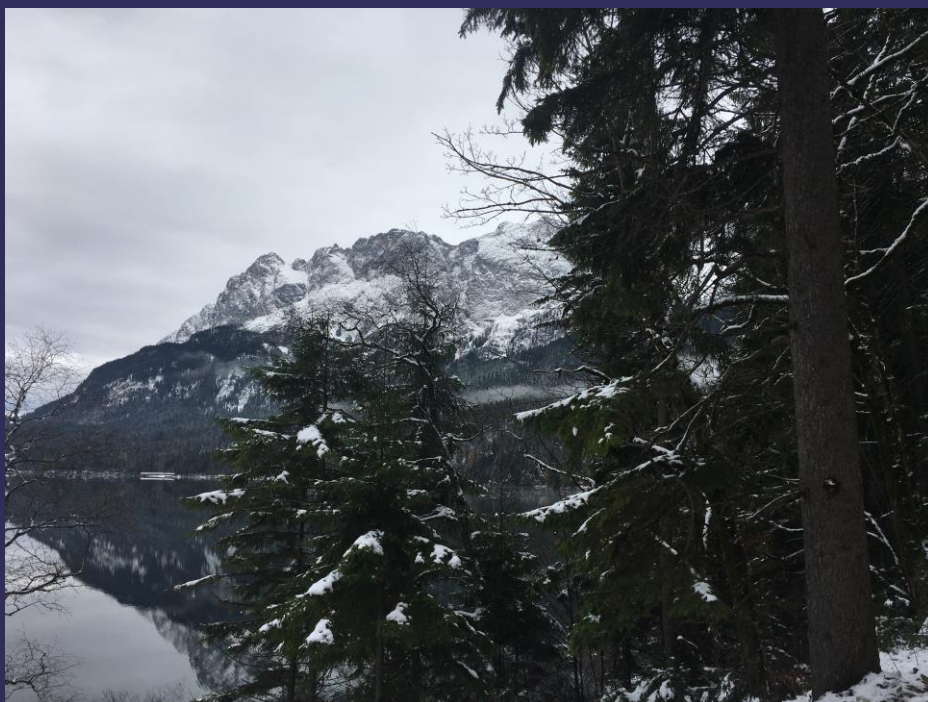


Newsletter January 2018:

3. Helsinki (8 patients randomized, 1 patient in observational arm)
4. Aachen (6 patients randomized)
5. Giessen (4 patients randomized, 2 patients in observational arm)
